**ADDITIONAL WARNINGS TO DEFENDANT:**

This is an official Court Order. If you disobey this Injunction (even if the Plaintiff contacts you), you may be arrested and prosecuted for the crime of interfering with judicial proceedings and any other crime you may have committed in disobeying this Injunction. Violations of this Injunction should be reported to a law enforcement agency, not the Court. Both parties must notify this Court if an action for dissolution (divorce), separation, annulment or paternity/maternity is filed. This is NOT a parenting time (visitation) or custody Injunction. You must file those requests separately in Superior Court. If you disagree with this Injunction, you have the right to request a hearing which will be held within 5 to 10 business days after your written request has been filed in the Court that issued this Injunction. Nothing Plaintiff does can stop, change, or undo this Injunction without the Court's written approval. You must appear in Court to ask a judge to modify (change) or quash (dismiss) this Injunction. **Even if the Plaintiff initiates contact, you could be arrested and prosecuted for violating this protective order. If you do not want the Plaintiff to contact you, you have the right to request a protective order against the Plaintiff.**
